Am I guaranteed a place?

Yes you are guaranteed a place once the following factors are done:

From the south

If you are coming by road, the M4 will bring you as far as Pont Abraham services, then take the A48 towards Carmarthen. At the end of the A48, follow the signs to Llandeilo at the first two roundabouts and at the third roundabout follow the A485 to Lampeter.

Travel by Train

Our nearest mainline railway stations are:

- Carmarthen for Cardiff, London and Southern England
- Aberystwyth for the Midlands, the North and Scotland

If you are travelling by train to Aberystwyth or Carmarthen for the Humanities Summer Academy, we will be offering a shuttle service to the Lampeter Campus.

- Aberystwyth – Lampeter Return

24 July: the shuttle service will leave the train station at **12:30pm**.

3 August: the shuttle service will leave the train station at **12:30pm**.

- Carmarthen – Lampeter Return

24 July: the shuttle service will be leaving Carmarthen train station at **1:00pm**.

3 August: the shuttle service will leave Lampeter Campus at 11:00am for those who will be catching the departing Carmarthen train at **12:33pm**.
